# Nepal Fact Sheet

Nepal, officially the Federal Democratic Republic of Nepal, is a landlocked country located in South Asia. It has a fast growing population of 31 million people. The country of Nepal shares land borders with China and India. The main people groups of Nepal are: Chhetri 16.6%, Brahmin-Hill 12.2%, Magar 7.1%, Tharu 6.5%, Tamang 5.8%, and Newar 5%. There are 125 caste/ethnic people groups in Nepal. The official language is Nepali, but English is the subsidiary official language. 1.4% of the population is evangelical Christian and the estimated percentage of evangelical growth per year is 10%. God is at work through the following:

## CORNERSTONES

- Evangelism - Four short-term mission teams visit Nepal for the purpose of evangelism and relief through SEAPC annually.
- Church Planting - SEAPC is working through New Day Destiny Center to plant churches in central Nepal and has distributed literature throughout 80% of the nation in partnership with David Evangelic Outreach since 1983.
- Disciple Making - SEAPC is making disciples and training young believers through New Day Destiny Center and Forerunner Flame Ministries. We are also developing a Bible training center in Damauli, Nepal.
- Leadership Development - SEAPC is hosting leadership events through New Day Destiny Center and Forerunner Flame Ministries.

## PLATFORMS

- Parenting - SEAPC is partnering with Mendies Haven Children's Home in Kathmandu to provide parenting to 25 orphaned or abandoned children.
- Education - New Day Destiny Center is establishing a network of preschools for early childhood intervention and community support through health and parental education programs.
- Healthcare - Short-term medical missions teams to children's homes and mountainous areas.
- Economic Development - SEAPC is setting up a farm to raise fish and pigs in partnership with New Day Destiny Center.

## SEEDBEDS

- Management - SEAPC-Nepal is led by Charles Mendies. Administrative oversight is provided by SEAPC.
- Development - SEAPC-Nepal is currently functioning on a \$50,000 annual budget.
- Accounting - Independent annual audits are provided locally. SEAPC is independently audited annually by Wessel & Company.
- Communications - Monthly, quarterly, and annual reporting is made available to all contributors.
