

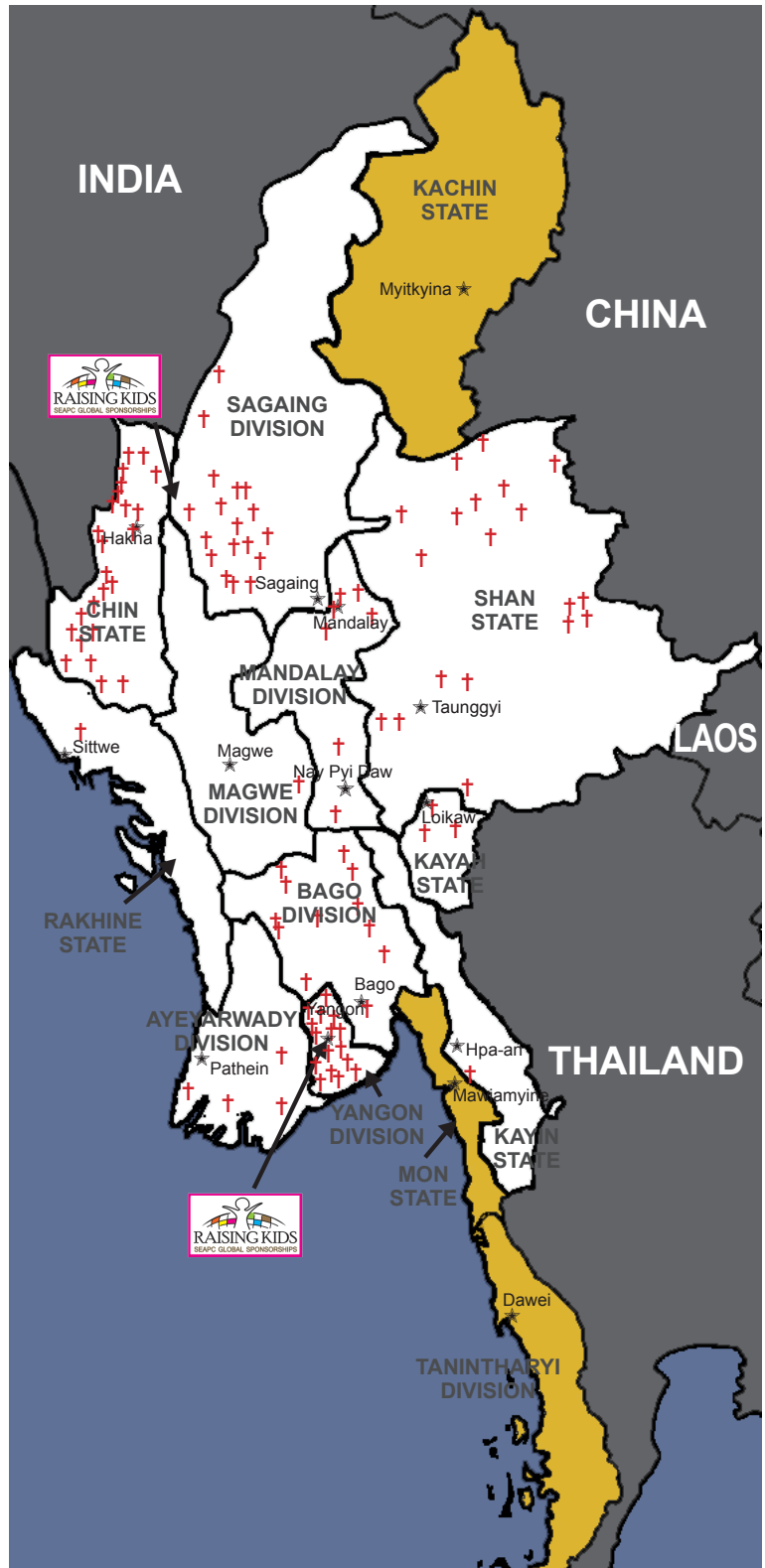

Myanmar Fact Sheet

Myanmar, officially known as the Republic of the Union of Myanmar, is also known as Burma. It is bordered by Bangladesh, India, China, Laos, and Thailand. It has a population of 51 million people and the official language is Burmese, although 116 other languages are spoken. Freedom of religion exists, at least according to the constitution, but some Christian minorities suffer greatly at the hands of the military. Buddhists make up about 80% of the population, while Christians account for only about 9%. Christianity and Islam are strong among several minority groups. God is at work through the following:

CORNERSTONES

- Evangelism - Each year, five short-term mission teams visit Myanmar through SEAPC for the purposes of evangelism.
- Church Planting - Through Acts Bible College, over 100 churches have been planted across Myanmar. The goal is to plant 10 new churches annually.
- Disciple Making - 120 students are enrolled in Acts Bible College and over 250 emerging ministry leaders participate in scholarship opportunities. More than 1,000 local leaders are engaged in discipleship programs.
- Leadership Development - SEAPC hosts five leadership events in Myanmar annually with over 5,000 participants.

PLATFORMS

- Parenting - Two SEAPC Charity Children's Homes are serving nearly 250 orphaned, abandoned, or at-risk children daily in Myanmar.
- Education - SEAPC is currently providing scholarships to students and researching the development of model schools.
- Healthcare - International medical teams visit Myanmar each year through SEAPC to serve the needs of villages.
- Economic Development - SEAPC-Myanmar has opened a water company as well as a travel company to offset local needs and to sustain new growth.

SEEDBEDS

- Management - SEAPC-Myanmar is led by Pastor James Lian Sai. Pastor Thang Chung Nung directs a 20 member staff for children's homes. In total there are 25 staff members.
- Development - SEAPC-Myanmar is currently functioning on a \$150,000 annual budget.
- Accounting - Independent annual audits are provided locally. SEAPC is independently audited annually by Wessel & Company.
- Communications - Monthly, quarterly, and annual reporting is made available to all contributors.
